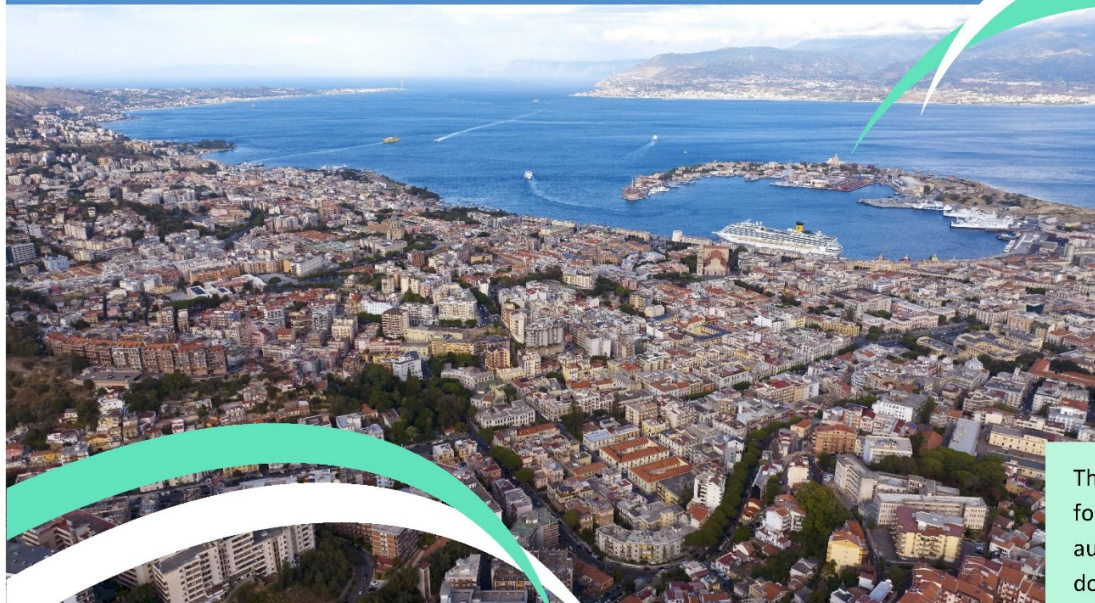

Call for Proposals

We welcome submissions for individual paper or panel proposals addressing **themes and inquiries** of philosophical significance **explored by Italian philosophers**.

We also welcome submissions for individual paper or panel proposals that explore **figures in the history of philosophy** as they are **taken up by Italian thinkers**.

Finally, we welcome submissions for individual paper or panel proposals focused on philosophical contributions from **Italian thinkers across history**.

Individual abstracts ranging from 350 to 500 words (in English) must be submitted by **January 10, 2027** using the QR code on this page. For panel proposals (up to three presenters), include a 350-word overview along with individual abstracts (350-500 words) for each presentation. All submissions will undergo anonymous review.

Notifications of acceptance will be sent by early March 2027.

The aim of SIP is to provide a forum for the discussion of themes, authors, and movements having to do with Italian philosophy as it is practiced both in Italy and abroad. Interdisciplinary and cross-cultural work of a philosophical nature is welcome. SIP's preferred language of conversation is English; Italian is acceptable but English translations *must* be provided.
